


Discovering Canavese Lands

Between vineyards and sanctuaries by e-bike

Route

From Acini e Rose, once you get on your e-bike, we recommend that you reach San Giorgio Canavese as the first stop.

Then proceed along Via XX Settembre and Via Trionfo, up to the intersection with Via Circonvallazione, where you continue to the right. From here follow the road that will take you in about 3 km near Villa Malfatti from where, along Via Biandrate, Via Meinardi and Via Piave, you will reach the central square of the town: Piazza S. Giorgio.

Here you can find the Costa Serra delicatessen - gastronomy and, if you continue along Via Carlo Alberto, after about 100 meters you will find the Pasticceria Roletti 1896 bakery, one of the historic places in Italy. In Via Campeggio 8 instead, (about 100 meters from Piazza San Giorgio), you will find the Ethnographic Museum Nòssi Ràis (our roots).

Now all you have to do is go back to Piazza San Giorgio and continue along Via Piave, Via Meinardi and Via Missionari Oblati, and then take the dirt road on your left that goes into the cool of the woods and then runs along the State Canal of Caluso, one of the oldest hydraulic infrastructures in the Canavese area.

At the end of the stretch on a dirt road, continue on the cycle path between Strada per Agliè and the Caluso canal. At the end of the the cycle path, proceed on asphalt and in a few minutes you will find yourself near the Ducal Castle of Agliè, along the beautiful Viale Cavaliere Don Feliciano Notario. Arriving at the Castle, we recommend that you take some time to visit the interiors, the Italian garden and its large greenhouses and the park with its centuries-old trees.

At the end of the visit to the castle, from Piazza Castello continue along Via Principe Tommaso and then turn right into Via per Cuceglio, skirting the boundary wall on your right that delimits the park of the Agliè Castle. Then turn left onto Strada Cascine Rogge and follow it to the intersection with Via Meleto. Here you turn right and you will soon find yourself near Villa Meleto, the house museum of Guido Gozzano. Also in this case, we recommend a stop to visit the interiors and the garden which have now been transformed into a real museum.

Continue now on Via Meleto and, at the intersection with Via per Santa Maria, turn left and go straight on for just over 1 km, until you meet the Piccolo Forno bakery pastry shop where we recommend you to buy the typical Agliè "torcetti", a tribute to the confectionery tradition of the Canavese area.

Now go back slightly and, turning left, go up towards the Church of Madonna delle Grazie. You will tackle a fairly steep climb but e-bikes will give you a big boost.







Now go back down to the main road (Via per Santa Maria), turn left and go back along the road traveled on the way there. Go straight on towards Vialfrè and, at the crossroads, take Strada Comunale per Vialfrè, going to the left. Proceed without detours for about 2.5 km to a park where you can stop for lunch. You are now in the municipality of Vialfrè, at the eastern end of the town. Here, upon your arrival, you will find a large green area where you can stop and take advantage of the presence of benches and tables, a water fountain and a children's play area.

Not far from here we advise you to reach the Chapel of San Pietro, seat of the parish of Vialfrè until the seventeenth century, .

Now continue along Via per Agliè passing through the characteristic historic center of Vialfrè. Continue along Via San Michele and turn right at the intersection with Via Circonvallazione, following the signs for Montalenghe and Cuceglio. Continue to follow the road until you cross the Provincial Road of Vialfrè (it is a very quiet road, surrounded by greenery and with little traffic). Continue on the SP55 for about 850 meters, then turn right onto the slightly uphill road. About 1 km separates you from your next destination: the Sanctuary of the Beata Vergine Addolorata of Cuceglio, which can be reached with a climb along the road called "Climb to the Eusebio Pastore Sanctuary".

Now go back to Via Bianco and turn right, towards the center of Cuceglio, take Via Convento and then turn left into Via XX Settembre. Continue along Via Mazzini and, subsequently, Via Porta Pia. At the intersection with Via per Agliè, turn left and continue always following Via Porta Pia for 2.6 km to the intersection with Via Michele Chiesa. Here, turn left and you will find yourself on the road you traveled on the way there.

After about 650 meters, turn left again and take Strada per Misobolo. Going along it for 1.6 km you will reach the Sanctuary of the Beata Vergine delle Grazie in Misobolo.

Now go back and continue along Strada Provinciale di Barone for about 450 meters, until you reach the Cieck Winery on your left. Here we recommend a stop to discover the "Erbaluce Route", all the secrets of this native wine: a walk through the rows, a visit to the cellar and, finally, a tasting accompanied by typical cheeses and salami.

Now go back to Strada Provinciale di Barone and then continue along Via Circonvallazione. At the intersection with Via Trionfo, turn left and then continue on Via XX Settembre, in the direction of Acini e Rose, returning to the starting point and thus ending your excursion.
